Ordering Restitution has many benefits for

Victims...

- *Holds the offender financially accountable to their victims for their criminal actions. Restitution can be added at the time of sentencing, during plea bargaining or during admission to diversionary programs such as Pretrial Intervention*
- *Places the financial burden on the offender NOT the victim or the victims' family, South Carolina tax payers and other community based victim assistance programs. Offenders CAN pay restitution while incarcerated as written in South Carolina Code of Laws Section 24-3-40 (A-1)*
- *Allows the Department of Crime Victim Compensation (DCVC) to continue financially assisting current and future victims during their time of need*
